SCHOLARSHIP CRITERIA

SETAP's Scholarship Fund is designed to provide SETAP members with financial assistance while they pursue a college education, certificate program, and/or professional certification. This is one way in which SETAP is promoting the professional advancement of the paralegal profession and of encouraging its members to strive for excellence through the pursuit of education.

SETAP will award a \$300 scholarship to one student member and a \$300 scholarship to one active or associate member each spring and fall semester. Scholarships will be awarded based on the objective and subjective evaluation of each applicant by the Scholarship Committee.

Members eligible to apply for scholarship funds include those classified as a student, active or associate member. To paraphrase SETAP bylaws, student members are those who are currently enrolled in a formal course of study.

Members may apply for either type scholarship. Scholarship applications must meet the criteria and adhere to the provisions below to qualify as a potential scholarship recipient.

DEGREE/CERTIFICATION PROGRAMS

Degree/certification programs related to the legal profession include those administered by a college, university, junior college, or proprietary school. Correspondence programs do not meet this qualification. A degree/certification applicant must:

- 1. Be a student, associate or active member in good standing (*i.e.*, dues are current).
- 2. Choose a topic from the application form and submit it with a two page essay on the chosen topic.

Recipients of a scholarship for degree/certification programs will receive funds upon verification of the above criteria.

PROFESSIONAL CERTIFICATIONS

Professional certifications include those issued by the National Association of Legal Assistants and the Texas Board of Legal Specialization. Scholarships may be applied to tuition for a preparatory/review course or to the examination fee. A professional certification applicant must:

- 1. Be a student, associate or active member in good standing (*i.e.*, dues are current).
- 2. Choose a topic from the application form and submit it with a two page essay on the chosen topic.

Recipients of a scholarship for professional certifications will receive funds upon proof of completion of either the review course or the examination.
